Reading unlocks the imagination and enhances your vocabulary, so this year we are asking all the children to dress up as a word.

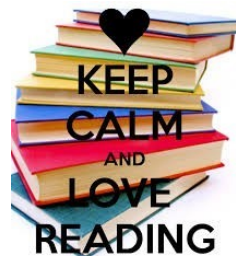
We will have a special parade on Friday to showcase the wide range of exciting, unusual and intriguing words.

WORKSHOPS
